At Cabot Primary School, we want our pupils to look smart and be proud of our school so we expect pupils to wear a uniform. We also want pupils to be focusing on their learning and not commenting on what others are wearing.

Uniform:

- Grey or black trousers or skirt. No jogging bottoms or jeans.
- Grey or black tights and socks.
- Plain white collared shirts (Polo shirts or button up)
- Cabot jumpers or plain blue jumpers or cardigans. (No hoodies or tracksuit jackets)
- Blue school summer dresses (checked or striped)
- Plain flat black shoes or ankle-high boots. (No opened toe sandals)

Acceptable



- ✓ Cabot School Jumper
- ✓ Dark coloured trousers/tights/leggings/socks or skirt (black or grey)
- ✓ Blue dress
- ✓ White collared shirt
- ✓ Black shoes or trainers











NOT Acceptable



- NO Jeans
- NO Joggers
- **NO** bright coloured trainers
- NO open toe sandals













Stud ear-rings only and no other jewellery should be worn. Pupils are welcome to wear a wrist-watch but not a smart watch due to safeguarding reasons. Plain hairbands and clips can be worn but without characters.

We understand some children may choose to wear a hijab. This is not part of our school uniform, but if your child does choose to wear one could you please make sure it is white in keeping with our uniform colour scheme.

PE Kit:

- Plain white T-shirt (short or long sleeved)
- Plain black shorts
- Plain black jogging trousers
- Cabot jumpers or plain blue jumpers or cardigans. (No hoodies or tracksuit jackets)
- Trainers or plimsols.

PE kit should be left in school for the whole term so that pupils can access it whenever needed. It can then go home at the end of term so that it can be washed and returned on the first day of the following term.

Book Bags/Backpacks

School uniform can be purchased from the school office. There is brand new uniform, as well as second-hand uniform that supports our school being eco-friendly too.
